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Why are psychological tests used? Because the **best** interventions begin with proper assessment.

Assessment can serve many purposes including: clinical screening, making a diagnosis, identifying strengths and weaknesses, educational programming such as IEP or 504 planning, or for the documentation of accommodations that are needed to find success on standardized exams such as the SAT or ACT as well as college and/or employment positions.

Psychological testing may hold the key in determining why a child or teen is not finding success in the school setting or why an adult may be struggling in college or in their work environment.

With regard to children, frustration with school may be an early warning sign that learning is difficult. A child can experience problems with school for many different reasons. Our staff will work with you, your child, and school personnel to obtain the answer. When evaluating adults, significant others are often interviewed and data may be collected from them to offer a more objective clinical viewpoint. *All evaluations are individualized to meet our clients' specific needs.*

Intelligence or Cognitive Testing

The Center employs state-of-the-art cognitive tests. We evaluate giftedness and provide documentation for Gifted and Talented Programs. Testing for Intellectual Disabilities is conducted for social and educational agencies.

Educational Testing

Educational or achievement testing is available to assess for specific learning disabilities such as dyslexia, dysgraphia or dyscalculia.

Personality & Emotional Functioning

Our staff conduct thorough diagnostic interviews and use standardized measures to help determine which factors or conditions are interfering with healthy social-emotional functioning. Depression, Bipolar Disorder, anxiety conditions including Generalized Anxiety Disorder (GAD), Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD) and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) are all evaluated by staff.

Autism Spectrum Disorder Assessment

We offer comprehensive testing for Autism Spectrum Disorders. Interview of caregivers and educators, assessment of current levels of functioning, information regarding communication, social interactions, unusual play, or sensitivity to sensory stimuli are routinely obtained. Behavioral observations and a variety of standardized Autism measures are also utilized.

Neuropsychological Testing

We provide complete evaluation of neuropsychological domains including attention, learning and memory skills, alertness, orientation, executive functioning, visuospatial abilities, as well as sensory and motor skills.

Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Assessment

Clients are tested for executive skills such as attention span, self-control, working memory and organizational abilities. Careful history-taking and direct consultation with families and school staff are always part of the assessment process for school-aged children. Interviews with significant others are utilized when evaluating adults.

Related Psychological Evaluations and Documentation

Psychological evaluations for adults are routinely conducted for government agencies (e.g., police department) to assist in the hiring and employment process, bariatric surgery clearance, and for testing accommodations such as extended time and separate location.

If an individual has a disability or suspects a disability, we always provide proper documentation with all necessary data regarding functional limitations.

Vocational, Career and "Best Fit" College Assessment
