Directions:

From the North Shore (West)

Go east on Northern State Parkway which becomes Route 347. After 12.3 miles, Route 347 becomes Route 25A. Go east for 2.7 miles. Office is on the left (North) side of Route 25A.

From the North Shore (East)

Go west on Sound Avenue which turns into Route 25A. Continue west for 8.4 miles. Office is on the right (North) side of Route 25A.

From the South Shore

Take Long Island Expressway (LIE or 495) East to Exit 63 North. Turn left at traffic signal onto N. Ocean Avenue/Route 83 (also known as Patchogue-Mt. Sinai Road). Go approximately 8 miles. Turn right on Route 25A. Go east for 1.6 miles. Office is on the left (North) side of Route 25A.
